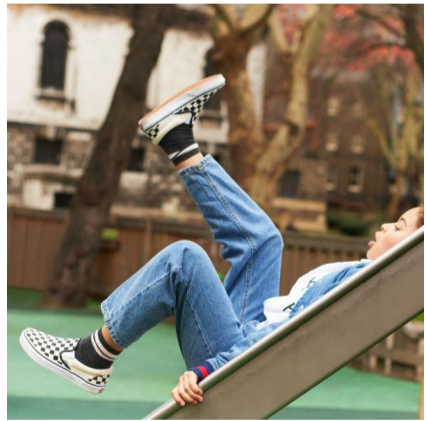


M&S
